	<p>There is to be a meeting with Kirsten England, Ian Cooper, Craig Whittaker and Amanda Byrne to look the work being carried out in Todmorden by Todmorden Pride and Todmorden Together.</p> <p>In addition Anne Holdsworth, Calderdale MBC Regeneration Department, is meeting with David and Louise to look at small projects in the Walsden Development Brief.</p>	
140/09/08	Todmorden Town Centre Renaissance Board	
	<p>Some concern was expressed in that it seems a number of mixed messages are coming out of Todmorden making it difficult for Calderdale officers to get a clear idea of what the different communities of Todmorden want from Regeneration. However, Todmorden Town Centre Renaissance Board (TTCRB) was set up to try and focus on the many issues required from the one scheme, but drawing from several groups.</p> <p>Since the last formal meeting of the TTCRB Cabinet have supported the acquisition of the Health Centre building; discussions are progressing between Calderdale MBC and the Primary Care Trust.</p> <p>It is anticipated that the next meeting will be in October, hopefully by then all reports should be in. A Development Brief can then be prepared further to which the project should be put out to public consultation. All stakeholders will be considered as well as the general public.</p> <p>Officers are doing as much as they can to bring this matter forward.</p>

	<p>Progress reports were handed out. It was noted that there is a lot of detail in the report and any group may speak on theirs.</p> <p>David - It is a case of getting schemes worked up and then generating match funding.</p> <p>The meeting was advised that Todmorden Town Council are proposing to employ a worker initially to deliver Todmorden Town Council projects but with the long term aim of developing the role into a Town Centre Manager. This will be incremental and it will be a big step but it is where the Town Council is heading.</p>
